Responsibilities:

- Attend Volunteer Committee on-boarding to become familiar with Dignity Seniors Society's programs, policies and operations, and thereafter assist with development and delivery of outreach strategies to welcome new members and engage existing members
- Attend monthly Committee meetings and other appropriate meetings when necessary
- Collaborate with Committee Members on projects and proposals and give input into proposed funding and partnering opportunities when necessary
- Provide on-going evaluation of the Volunteer Committee structure and performance
- Understand and promote Dignity Seniors Society's mission and values

- Participate in special events relevant to the Committee as needed
- Adhere to the Volunteer Committee conduct guidelines and policies
- Attend and participate in annual strategic planning sessions and general meetings
